Program Objectives

After the presentation the participant will be able to:

- Improve understanding of mechanisms of sepsis and initial management of the septic patient
- Understand the CDC changes in ventilator acquired conditions, events and how it effects reimbursement
- Recognize the impact of services on the bottom line
- Recognizing the clinical signs of severe asthma
- Identify normal ABG values and interpret the meaning of abnormal values
- To provide in depth example of ethical and unethical behavior
- Increase understanding of the multifaceted, non-respiratory, unexpected problems faced at high altitude by patients including retinopathy, cerebral edema, coagulation abnormalities, renal syndrome, inflammation, and an increase in cardiovascular risk factors
- Discuss Indications for testing, Mannitol Challenge Procedure, Interpretation of results and review direct vs indirect challenge tests
- Identify how to utilize multidisciplinary health care providers to effectively coach COPD patients after discharge and reduce readmission rates
- Understand the ATS & Quality Guidelines for PFT's
- Understand & Describe how Respiratory Therapists integrated into care teams prevent readmissions – will discuss new medications used in direct or adjunct treatment of COPD
- Learn how using Motivational Interviewing is an effective tool to improve adherence with therapy
